One hundred percent of all the funds raised through C.A.S.U.A.L. DaySM stay in Northeast Pennsylvania to support colorectal cancer prevention and early detection education, screenings, and the Northeast Regional Cancer Institute's Community-Based Cancer Screening Navigation Program.
